## **Chugach Travel Eligibility**

Throughout their educational career Chugach students will have many opportunities to participate in programs that require travel outside the school. Participation in these travel activities is a privilege that must be earned through proper behaviour and academic progress. As stated in the Student Handbook, a student must meet the following requirements in order to take advantage of these programs.

- Maintain at least a developing mark in each standard area on the report card.
- Maintain a genuine and sincere effort to progress to the next level in each class, which will be determined by the student's teacher.
- Maintain proper behaviour as per school rules.
- Maintain regular attendance.
- Students must be in attendance the entire day of scheduled activity to maintain eligibility for participation that day.

Students who do not meet with any of the above criteria are not eligible to participate in these programs until the Teacher and Principal deem that the student has taken appropriate, meaningful action to correct the problem.

For any student who cancels travel plans without approval in a time frame that does not allow the district to either find a replacement or regain the costs of travel, the student is not eligible to travel until the district has been reimbursed.

In the event that a student violates any rules or codes of conduct while travelling with a district program they will be immediately sent home at their expense.

In order to regain eligibility to travel within the same school year that a violation occurs the student must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Formally apologize to the staff or program affected by the student's behaviours.
- 2. The District has been reimbursed for any travel expenses incurred by sending the student home early.
- 3. The student will need to maintain all requirements for travel eligibility as well as obtain a recommendation from a staff member regarding their readiness to participate in travel activities.

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
