Posting a video on a blog:

First, save the file to make sure that nothing happens to it. If you're using iMovie, make sure to export it to Quicktime first to convert it to a .mov file. Actually, it's ok as long as it's one of the valid video files:

Valid video extensions are: 3g2, 3gp, 3gp2, 3gpp, 3p, asf, avi, divx, divx, dv, dvx, flv, gif, moov, mov, mp4, mpeg4, mpg4, mpe, mpeg, mpg, qt, swf, wmv, xvid.

Next, create an account by going to www.photobucket.com (others work too.) After the account is created, choose to upload a video. After a few seconds of uploading, click on the box titled HTML tag:

After clicking on it, the whole box should automatically highlight:

```

Press Ctrl+C (or Command+C) and go to your blog. Depending on the blog, you should just be able to paste the code onto the post, and it should appear as a video. If not, most blogs come with a Hyperlink button:



A window should pop up, allowing you to enter the code. After a few seconds, you should be able to post it. Enjoy the video on your blog!
